Paper text paragraphs: Times New Roman font 12pt, Spacing before = 6 pt., after = 0, No Indentation, Spacing 1.2 lines, Justified.

1. Heading1: Times New Roman font 14pt, bold, alignment left, Spacing before=12pt, after=0

1.1. Heading2: Times New Roman font 12pt, bold, alignment left, Spacing before=6pt, after=0

Equations: Use only Times New Roman or the Symbol font.

$$x = y + z \quad (1)$$

Number equations consecutively. Equation numbers, within parentheses, are to position flush right, as in (1), using a right tab stop. Equation is centered using a center tab stop. When citing in text, use only "(1)", not "Eq. (1)" or "equation (1)", with the exception of the beginning of a sentence: "Equation (1) is ..."

Figures and tables: Place figures and tables at the top and bottom of pages. Avoid placing them in the middle of pages. Figure captions should be below the figures; table heads should appear above the tables. Figure labels and table heads should use 10 point Times New Roman.
